TE Offices to close and services will transfer to municipalities

TE Office is a state authority that organises and produces employment and economic development services in Finland. The operations of all TE offices will end on 31 December 2024, and TE services will be transferred to the employment areas consisting of different municipalities on 1 January 2025. Job Market Finland and Job Market Finland's E-Services will remain as they are after the change. Through the E-Services, you can, for example, register as an unemployed jobseeker, report changes in your situation, and manage other matters related to your job search if you are living in Finland.
